ParentPay – After School Clubs and Breakfast Club Charges

You may have noticed a few changes to your ParentPay account. To clarify, 'tennis wraparound' is for those children who attend tennis with Tennis Rocks and then go on to after school club with Mrs Deniz from 4.00pm – 5.00pm – this session is charged at £5.00. 'Football wraparound' again is for those children who attend football club with Soccer Revolution and then go on to After School Club with Mrs Deniz from 4.40pm – 5.00pm – this session is charged at £2.50.

After School Club with Mrs Deniz from 3.15pm - 4.15pm is $\pounds 5.00$ and from 3.15pm - 5.00pm is $\pounds 8.75$. Breakfast Club is from 8.00am - 8.50am and is charged at $\pounds 4.00 - even$ if your child arrives late for Breakfast Club, you will still be charged the full rate.


