Re: Head Teacher's Update July 2023

I just wanted to update you all as we come to the end of the school year.

We have had some great Sports Days over the last two weeks with lots of fun activities and exercise for all the children in Reception to Year 6. The children were brilliant! Thank you to Miss Powell for organising the weeks, along with Coach Anna and the Foundation Sports Coaches, volunteers and to our Media team and DJs for playing music and taking many photos of the events.

The Sports Day House Points were as follows:

Reception:
