Dear Parents and Carers

END OF YEAR SCHOOL REPORTS

All our school reports will be handed out on Monday 10th July 2023. On this day we will have an Open Day for all our current parents and carers from 4pm to 6pm. Everyone is welcome to come and see the children's work and meet the current teacher and also say hello to the new class teachers for September 2023- no appointments are needed. Year 6 reports will go out mid-week as their Year 6 SATS results for Reading, (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Maths are not published by the DfE until 11th July 2023.

The children will have the opportunity to meet their new teachers and staff on Monday 10th July 2023 in the afternoon. A full list of our school staffing will also be sent out to all our parents and carers.

All our July reports cover pupil achievements, general progress, attendance and any statutory data.

Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) – (Reception) –

Our Early Years Foundation Stage Reports comment on Personal, Social and Emotional Development; Communication, Language and Literacy; Mathematics; Physical Development; Other areas of learning and how your child learns. The report includes a summary of the results of the EYFS profile. The profile scores in each area are either Emerging or Expected. There is no score for exceeding from the government profile.

Year One - Year One Phonics Screening Check- This was carried out in June 2023 and the scores are out of 40. The pass mark is 32 out of 40.

Year Two – pupils that took part in the recheck will also have a score sheet for phonics.

Year Two – Following the KS1 SATs, Teacher Assessment outcomes are informed by the results of the statutory English Reading and Mathematics tests. In Science there is no official score for exceeding from the DfE.

Year Four – All the children took part in the Multiplication Test Check (MTC). The scores are out of 25 but there is no government standardised score.

Year Six – All the children took part in the KS2 SATs. The KS2 SATs assessment results are based on Reading, (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Mathematics, with an end of year score included for these areas. Teacher Assessments are based on Writing and Science. In Science there is no official score for exceeding from the DfE.

In Years 1-6 all reports have comments for English (Reading and Writing), Mathematics, Science with effort and achievements noted. A summary of results are included for Computing, RE, Humanities, Music, PE, Art, DT, Spanish. PSHE and General Comments are also noted. Reports include whether your child is working below, working towards, at the expected standards or working at greater depth within the expected standard.

If you have any questions in regards to the school reports, you will have the opportunity to see the class teacher at the Open Day on Monday 10th July at 4pm-6pm. Everyone is welcome to pop in for the Open Day to meet our staff and see the children's work. There is no need to book an appointment – everyone is welcome to meet the staff during this time.
