Sports Week: Week Commencing 1st July 2024

We are all very excited that our sports week is approaching during the first week of July. We are really looking forward to encouraging the children to engage in a number of sporting activities across the week!

Throughout the week, there will be a variety of activities taking place for the children to participate in, including a carousel of sports, an obstacle course and a competitive sports day. During the sports days, the children in EYFS and KS1 will be participating in a range of events such as an egg and spoon race, relay, sack race, hurdles and an obstacle course.
