Project Update

Welcome to Dear Neighbour, the monthly newsletter that keeps everyone up to date with progress on the Ashmole Primary school project.

Since the last newsletter you will have noticed a large amount of progress happening on site.

The ground floor SIPS panels have been delivered and craned into place, ready for the arrival of the precast concrete first floor slab. The remaining first floor panels are due to arrive and be craned into place over the next 9 weeks.

This is logistically the most challenging part of the build and will involve a lot of coordination to ensure that deliveries of the panels happen smoothly and with as little disruption as possible to the school and public.

February also saw us complete the concrete works including; all foundations, slabs and up stands. We have installed ducting across the school entrance to minimise any future electrical installation disruption and we have also completed the ball netting to the playing fields.

Morgan Sindall are committed to minimising the impact of our operations on the environment and have methods and processes in place to monitor this. On site we have installed tree protection to ensure the trees are not damaged during the construction period.

WINTER NIGHT SHELTER COLLECTION

Between January and March the site team are supporting Enfield Churches Winter Night Shelter drive, managed by the charity All People All Places. The team are collecting food, clothing, and bedding and regularly donating them to St Andrew's Southgate, one of the churches involved in the drive.

The shelter offers a hot meal and a bed for the night to up to 12 homeless people with low support needs who are referred by APAP.

Seven churches in Enfield take part in the scheme between January and March.
