

YEAR 1 SUMMER MEDIUM TERM PLANNING

This term our theme is 'A Toy's Story.' The children in Year 1 will begin the topic by thinking carefully about their favourite toys, the materials that they are made from and how they work. We will be comparing how features of toys have changed over time. They will not only be studying different toy artefacts, they will also experience playing a variety of playground games from the past. The children will look closely at how different toys are made and how they work, investigating the forces exerted on them to allow them to move. Furthermore, they will be designing and making their own puppet and develop their sewing skills.
