Welcome to Dear Neighbour, the monthly newsletter that keeps everyone up to date with progress on the Ashmole **Primary school project.**

Since the weather has started to improve it seems works on-site have moved forward at a rapid pace.

The roof works are now 60% complete and the drylining to the classrooms is due to complete by the end of the month.

The mechanical ventilation has now been installed and utilities are now live except fot the water and drainage connections.

The windows are 80% complete and this will be finished by the end of the month.

Over the coming weeks the roofing will be completed and the brickwork and cladding will commence on site.

Internally the drylining is progressing with the plastering starting this week. The Mechanical and electrical installation is nearly finished on the ground floor and will move up to first floor.

Over the next month we have the finishing trades lined up including the painters and decorators and flooring which will make the internal spaces feel like they are nearing completion.
