£1320 per pupil
Reception- 2 pupils. Projects: Participation in Drama and Literacy and Social skills in clubs and in class.
Costs: Class resources: books, games and role play activities (£2145) and £495 for clubs.
Objectives: To build on self-esteem and confidence. To build on dance, drama and singing skills to aid Literacy work.
Outcomes: 1 pupils achieved ELG2 and 1 pupil achieved ELG 1. To continue to monitor attendance of one pupil.

Year 1- 1 pupil. Projects and costs: Football £165 per year; Tennis £180 per year; Drama £495 per year; Breakfast Club and After School Club over the year (£480).
