Head Teacher's Message:



We have had a very busy month at Ashmole Primary School with so many exciting events that the children have participated in. I would like to say a huge thank you to the APPTA for organising an amazing Christmas Fair this year. Thank you to all our parents, staff and families for attending the event. We are very grateful to all our sponsors including our main sponsor-Unique Estate Agents that kindly donated an amazing £1000! In total the APPTA raised nearly £6000, with expenses to be deducted. The APPTA have kindly donated £10,000 to our school to support the purchase of new climbing equipment for KS1 and a further £1000 towards the Early Years Outdoor Play area. In addition the APPTA have helped purchase for each class some classroom games for wet play with a £20 donation per class. As promised all money raised by the APPTA always goes back to the children.

Looking back at this month, it is remarkable the amount of things we have actually achieved at school. We have had a focus on Road Safety with children creating banners; Bling Your Bike to school day; Pantomime Visit; Christmas Jumper Day and lunch; a visit to the Academy to watch the Sound of Music and Reception and Y1 have performed their own Nativity story which was a great success. A special DVD will be available in the New Year. In addition to this the children have continued their Spanish classes each week and Reception classes will also be learning Spanish from the new year.

I am very pleased to say that the school building project is officially over! Morgan Sindall have now left our site and have completed the car park and Multi Use Games Area (MUGA). Thank you to all our parents for your tremendous patience and understanding over the last couple of years with all the building work that has happened here at Ashmole Primary School. We hope that it has all been well worth it! The car park will be used only by the staff from January 2019. There will be drop off zone eventually in place but not yet. The children at our school are still only in Reception-Y2 and they are too young to just be dropped off in the car park but this is something that we will look at in the near future. The MUGA is now ready and we will purchase two football goals, two netball posts and two basketball posts for this area. This will be used by the children from January- predominantly by Y2 but also for all PE lessons and activities for all the children.

I would like to wish everyone an amazing Christmas Holiday and a Happy New Year 2019! We look forward to seeing you all again on Monday 7th January with school registration at 8.50am. Best wishes and thank you for all your fantastic support.








New Climbing Frames

Car Park and MUGA

Morgan Sindall have completed the new Multi Use Games Area and car park. The Local Highways department will complete the yellow lines and zig zags and repair the street paving in the Easter or Summer Holidays 2019. Morgan Sindall will still be around over the next eight months with their After Care Team to ensure of any essential maintenance or repair work. We will also aim to increase the size of the fencing via netting around the MUGA area so that balls do not keep going over onto the field.

Reception News



Calypso Class loved reading all about Elmer the colourful elephant! We talked about the things that make us different to each other and celebrated these differences as things that make us all special. Then the children spent some time designing their own special elephants. We took them for an 'Elephant Parade' just like in the story.

Year 1 News



Luna Class have been learning about the Christian celebration of Christmas in RE. We made Christingles and learnt about the symbolism of the different parts of the Christingle. In Science, we have been identifying different animal groups and this term we have investigated birds and fish.

In Science **Nova Class** have begun to look at the five main animal groups - Amphibians, Reptiles, Mammals, Fish and Birds. We looked closely at the different features of a bird and fish.





Year 2 News



Lyra Class have been learning lots about shapes and patterns in maths. They have investigated the different properties that 2D and 3D shapes have and used these skills to apply them to making repeated patterns. The children had an amazing time watching the Beauty and the Beast Pantomime. As they loved it so much, we asked them to write a recount about their trip. In D&T the children planned and designed their bridges before making them.



Carina Class have been exploring taking and editing photos on our iPads and laptops in our Computing lessons. We used the Picasa 3 Software to edit our photos by changing the colours, editing the brightness and adding shadows.

We have also been learning how to safely use a variety of tools in Design and Technology such as saws and glue guns. We used these tools to make our wooden bridges which we had planned and designed in small groups.
