#### Year 3

Pupils will finish school from September 2019 in Year 3 at 3.25pm. This is to help stagger home times but also to ensure our statutory obligation where pupils in KS2 have slightly more learning time than in KS1. Parents of pupils in Year 3 and above have to now pay for school meals and these will be charged at £2.55 a day. Lunch will still be served at the normal time of 12.10pm and will finish at 1.10pm for Y3 pupils. A letter has gone out to our current Y2 parents which explains how this should be done in advance. We would like our parents with Y3 pupils in September to pay 6 weeks in advance via Parent Pay. Please kindly top up your child's account before we start back in September and we will keep registers of the children having a school lunch each day. Thank you.

#### September 2019

We plan to purchase further resources to keep improving our school. Our plans include a new stage for the hall, two new portable PA speakers, wall bars and climbing ropes for our children.




