Head Teacher's Message:

Dear Parents and Carers

As you will all be aware, the government outlined plans for schools to start opening to some year groups in June 2020. The plan is to open school for the children only in Reception and Year 1 from 3rd June. This is a conditional plan which will remain under regular review. As a school we will follow the guidance of the Department of Education to ensure that we keep our children, staff and families safe. We receive a daily update from the Department of Education and have prepared a strategy and risk assessment for our reopening. Our provision for key worker children from Year 2 and Year 3 will continue as normal and those children will be located upstairs in the future Year 5 classrooms.

Our plan is to hold two INSET Days for staff on Monday 1st June and Tuesday 2nd June to brief them fully on expectations and regulations and to go over the risk assessment. The safety of our pupils and staff is paramount and we are fully prepared to open for our Reception and Year 1 pupils on Wednesday 3rd June. To ensure safe social distancing, everyone on site will have to abide by the 2 metre rule and no class group will be larger than 15 pupils. The Reception children will be based either in their Reception classroom or in the Hall. The Year 1 children will be based either in their classroom or in one of the Year 2 classrooms. Again, all groups will be taught with a maximum of 15 pupils at one time. The groups will be led by the Teacher, a High Level Teaching Assistant or a Teaching Assistant.

The times will be slightly staggered to aid with social distancing in the playground during the busy periods. Reception opening times: 8.45am Register and 2pm pick up. Year 1 opening times: 9.00am Register and 2.15pm pick up. The class teachers will confirm drop off and pick up locations to the parents before 3rd June.

On their return to school, the children will predominantly focus on well-being lessons and activities with their teachers and peers. Pupils will be kept apart as previously mentioned and will be based in their set area with their set adults. The pupils will also eat in their class areas. We will steadily build on a return to our school curriculum. We understand that some parents may be anxious about any return to school and we totally understand this. If parents choose not to send their child back to school there will be no consequences or fines for non-attendance. We will respect your decision completely.

Our staff are here to support the children and as a school we will understand if you may not be ready to return straight away in June.

Our staff have been busy contacting all our Reception and Year 1 parents, so that we can know how many children will come back to school and plan accordingly. Social distancing measures to combat this hidden virus are so important. Please ensure all rules and quidelines are followed on the school site at all times. If you need to send a message to the teacher please do so via telephone or email the office office@ashmoleprimary.org 0208 361 1881. It will be difficult to talk directly to staff face to face given the current climate and I thank you all for your understanding with this matter during this difficult time. We need to protect each other and be socially aware. I would like to finish by saying thank you to so many of you who have been so supportive of the school and the hard work that all the staff continue to put in to make sure your children continue to be educated at home. Your positive feedback means so much to us and goes a long way. We appreciate that home schooling isn't always easy especially for parents who are also working from home. Some parents are asking for interactive, live lessons such as zoom. At Ashmole, both the Academy and the Primary, we will not be using the Zoom platform for live lessons simply because it has potential safeguarding issues used in this context and our prime duty is to protect the welfare of our pupils. Practical issues of having a live lesson with 30 students at the same time is also not practical for every household. However, as distance learning continues to be a feature, especially for Years 2 and 3 we will look to develop more ways to enhance our online learning and will ensure more online interaction. The Year 2 and Year 3 staff will contact parents after half-term.

Best wishes to everyone, enjoy the half-term break and please stay safe.


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Reception
