Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to all our pupils, staff, parents, carers and governors and an extended warm welcome to our new starters who have joined us in Reception, Year 1 and Year 3. This September, Miss Zimmerman-Moles joins the office team as our part-time Finance Assistant.. We welcome all of our new starters and wish them every happiness at Ashmole.

Our Reception children have settled in remarkably well given that they were unable to visit our school or even meet their new teachers and peers before their start in September.

I am pleased that we are able to open our school to all our pupils and I certainly want it to remain that way throughout the academic year. I have introduced certain measures this term such as the introduction of face masks for adults during drop off and pick up times. This will certainly help keep the transmission of the virus at bay. I would also like to reiterate the need for social distancing in the playground and that pupils should be dropped off and collected by one parent/carer only at a time. I must also stress the importance of vacating the premises as soon as you have dropped off and collected your child. Children and their siblings should not play with the playground equipment during these times. The equipment is to be used for pupils only during the school day at playtime and lunchtime.

Finally, I'm sure you would agree that the children's wellbeing is very important and with this in mind we have decided to have a Fun Day tomorrow! The children can come to school dressed in an outfit of their choice and as a special treat, Thursday's lunch menu will be replaced with Friday's menu. If your child does not usually have school dinners and they wish to do so, please let the school office know.




