#### Message from the Head Teacher

Dear Parents and Carers

As we come to the end of yet another turbulent academic year, I wanted to take this opportunity to thank all our parents/carers, governors, staff and especially our pupils. The resilience they have shown over these last 18 months is nothing short of amazing. This generation of children have had to cope with such a lot during this time and we are all so very proud of each and every one of them. I am so pleased that our school has managed to stay Covid free over the last few months and that we have not had to close any classes. This is a reflection of the hard work of our parents/carers and staff; thank you for continuing to wear face coverings whilst on site which I believe, has certainly helped to keep the transmission of the virus at bay in our school community.

As from 19th July, the government guidance will change and social distancing measures will be lifted. The wearing of masks will not be necessary whilst on school premises. From September school will go back to it's normal drop-off and pick-up times of 8.50am - 3.15pm for pupils in Reception - Year 2; and 8.50am - 3.25pm for pupils in Year 3 - Year 5. For those pupils moving up to KS2, the school day is slightly longer to enable the teaching of more lessons for pupils in KS2. Year 5 will line up on the MUGA in the mornings where the Year 5 staff will greet them. I am pleased that we are able to trial the Year 5 drop-off and pick-up zone from September. An email about this was sent to our future Year 5 parents yesterday. If you did not receive the email, please let Mrs Andrews know as soon as possible. This trial is safety dependent so if we feel that the safety of our pupils is being compromised, we hold the right to modify the offering.

The last few weeks of term are always extremely busy, but we have also managed to have some fun too! With thanks to Miss Cleary, the children enjoyed a fabulous sports day and with the generous offering to film the occasion from Mr Wightman and the Media students at Ashmole  $6^{th}$  Form, our parents and carers were able to cheer their children on virtually! Thank you so much to Mr Wightman for giving us his time so generously and for all the other wonderful projects that he has been involved with this term. Well done to the Yellow Diamonds for being the Summer House Point Champions!

Many thanks to the APPTA for organising the Fun Day. The children had so much fun on the inflatables and enjoyed the many different events too.
