Homework will be sent home every Friday. Please return all completed homework to school on Wednesday, in your child's homework folder. Thank you.



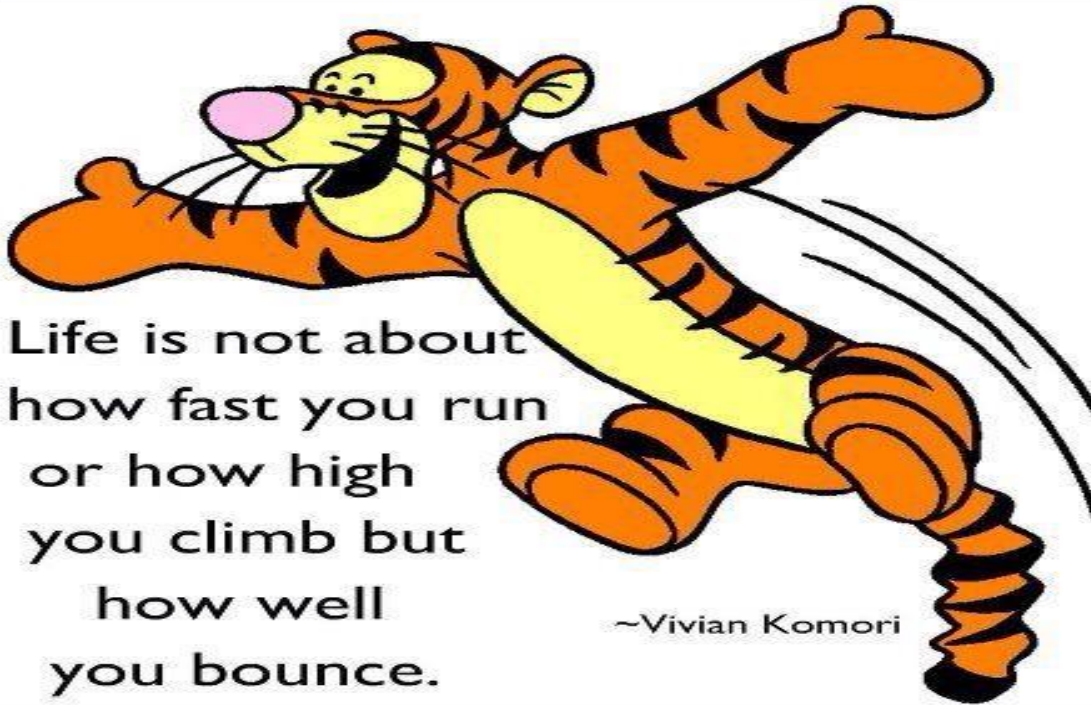
Child Tax Credits
